

DAY 1 • (Tuesday, January 07) - (EWR) Newark, NJ - TEL AVIV. Depart from (EWR) Newark Airport, NJ to Ben Gurion Airport, Tel Aviv. Dinner and breakfast will be served on board.

DAY 2 • (Wednesday, January 08) - CAESAREA • STELLA MARIS • GALILEE Awaken to a glorious dawn! The excitement begins the moment we arrive and prepare ourselves for a life changing experience in Holy Land following the footsteps of Jesus and Mary. Upon arrival, our local tour guide will meet us after our airport formalities. It will be followed by a relaxing journey along the coastal road to **Caesarea Maritima**. We will visit Herod's masterpieces including the **Roman Aqueduct Theater, Herod's Palace, Hippodrome** and the **Harbor**, where St. Paul sailed on from here to his mission abroad. Then we visit the **city of Haifa, Our Lady of M t. Carmel and Elijah's Grotto**. We will have our Mass at **el-Muhraqa**. We will stop by **Tel Meggido** on our way to Tiberias. We will check-in to our hotel followed by a dinner and rest.

DAY 3 • (Thursday, January 09) - CAESARIA PHILLIPI- SEPPHORIS • CANA • NAZARETH • SYNAGOGUE. After breakfast, we go to **Caesaria**

Philippi (Baniyas) then to **Sepphoris**. In the afternoon, we will visit **Kafr Kanna** and have the renewal of Catholic marriage vows for couples. Then we proceed to **Nazareth** to visit and have the Mass at the **Basilica of the Annunciation** - the place where the archangel Gabriel appeared to Mary. We will visit **Mary and Joseph's house**, where Jesus spent about 30 years of his life, then visit the Church of St. Joseph. We will also visit a **local synagogue** in Nazareth.

DAY 4 - (Friday, January 10) - BEIT SHE'AN, MAGDALA • MT. OF BEATITUDES • YIGAL ALON MUSEUM • BOAT RIDE • TABGHA •

MENSA CHRISTI • CAPERNAUM. We begin our day at **Beit She'an** then we visit the hometown of Saint Mary Magdalene - **Migdal (Magdaia)** then we go to **M t. of Beatitudes** for our Mass. After we visit the **Yigal Alon Museum** then enjoy a relaxing **boat ride on the Sea of Galilee**. We continue to **Tabgha** - site of the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves & fishes. Then we proceed to the **Church of the Primacy of St. Peter** where we see the "Mensa Christi." Then we go to **Capernaum** - the town of Jesus. Here we will see the House of St. Peter and one of the ancient synagogues.

DAY 5 • (Saturday, January 11) - MT. TABOR • QASR EL YAHUD • JORDAN RIVER • JERICHO • MT. OF TEMPTATIONS • SYCAMORE TREE • MASADA, THE DEAD SEA. Today, we will have our mass at **Mount Tabor**, the site of the

Transfiguration then continue to **Qasr el Yahud** where we have the renewal of baptismal vows at the **Jordan River**. We proceed to **Jericho**, the oldest city in the world with spectacular view of the **Mount of Temptations**. We will have our Mass at the Church of the Good Shepherd. We will see the sycamore tree on our way to **Jericho**. We will visit **Masada** and then have an opportunity to swim in the **Dead Sea**. We will check-in to a hotel near the Dead Sea.

DAY 6 - (Sunday, January 12) - QUMRAN • WADI QELT IN SAMARIA, BETHLEHEM • SHEPHERD'S FIELD • MILK GROTTO CHURCH • CHURCH OF THE NATIVITY • BIBLE LAND MUSEUM.

Today, we go to **Qumran** ruins where the Dead Sea scrolls were found then visit **Samaria** in **Wadi Qelt** overlooking St. George Monastery. Then we go to **Bethlehem** - the birthplace of Jesus and David. We will have our Mass at the **Shepherds' Field**. We go to the **Church of the Nativity** to venerate the very birth location of Jesus Christ. Then we go to **Milk Grotto Church**. We will check into a hotel in Jerusalem.

DAY 7 • (Monday, January 13) - BEITPHAGE CHURCH • DOME OF THE ASCENSION • CHURCH OF PATER NOSTER • MOUNT OF OLIVES, GARDEN OF GETSEMANI • KIDRON VALLEY • MOUNT ZION • ROOM OF THE LAST SUPPER • DAVID'S TOMB • DORMITION ABBEY • ST. PETER

DAY 8 • (Tuesday, January 14) - CHURCH OF ST. ANNE • POOL OF BETHESDA • CITY OF DAVID • TEMPLE MOUNT • CANAANITE/ H EZEKIAH'S TUNNEL • YAO VASHEM MUSEUM • EIN KEREM.

This morning we visit the **Church of St. Anne, Pool of Bethesda**, then to the **City of David**. We will walk through **Canaanite/ King Hezekiah's Tunnel** to the **Pool of Siloam**. Then after our visit to the **Temple Mount**, we proceed to

Yad Vashem Museum. We go to the village of **Ein Kerem** - the birthplace of St John the Baptist, **the Church of the Visitation, the Church of St. John the Baptist and Mary's Spring**.

DAY 9 • (Wednesday, January 15) - JERUSAELM • ECCE HOMO • VIA DOLOROSA • CHURCH OF THE HOLY SEPULCHRE • BIBLE LAND MUSEUM • BETHANY (CHURCH OF LAZARUS)

We will solemnly pray the **Via Dolorosa**. Along the way, we will visit the **Church of Condemnation, Church of Flagellation, Ecce Homo Arch**. We will have a Mass at the **Church of the Holy Sepulcher**. Here we visit the location where Jesus Christ was crucified, died, buried, and resurrected. We visit the empty **tomb of Jesus**, the **Chapel of the Angel**, the site where the True Cross had been found. Then we go to the **Bible Land Museum** to see the Model of the Old City of Jerusalem and the Dead Sea Scrolls. Then we proceed to **Bethany** at the **Church of Lazarus**.

DAY 10 - (Thursday, January 16) - JERUSALEM • CARDO MAXIMUS, DOME OF THE ROCK • AL-AQSA MOSQUE • WESTERN WALL •

EMMAUS/NICOPOLIS/IMWAS • JAFFA • TEL AVIV. Today, we the **Old City of Jerusalem, Cardo Maximus, Dome of the Rock, Al-Aqsa Mosque**, and the **Western Wall**. After the final shopping, we will have our Mass at **Emmaus**

Nicopolis, where we see the ruins of the 12th century church, which now marks the village of **Emmaus** where Jesus appeared to two disciples after Resurrection. Then we will have a quick visit to the **Old Port City of Jaffa**. In the evening, we enjoy a farewell dinner at a local restaurant before departing Tel Aviv back to New Jersey, USA.

DAY 11 • (Friday, January 17) • (EWR) NJ, USA. Arrive in **Newark, NJ** filled with grace and blessings from the retreat-pilgrimage to the Holy Land.
