

Join St. Francis of Assisi - St. Blaise Church's Jubilee Pilgrimage to Italy October 19–27, 2026



YOUR DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

DAY 1: NEW YORK/ROME

We depart on an international overnight flight to Rome. Dinner and breakfast are served on board.

DAY 2: ROME

Upon arrival in Rome, we are greeted by our tour guide, and next board our deluxe motorcoach for transfer to our hotel. The balance of the day is at leisure to rest or explore the city on our own. Dinner and overnight in Rome. (D)

DAY 3: ROME

After breakfast we depart for the Vatican City, where we gather with pilgrims from around the world to attend a Papal Audience (if available). In the afternoon, we visit the Vatican Museums, home to one of the world's greatest art collections, and Michelangelo's breathtaking Sistine Chapel followed by a tour of St. Peter's Basilica, the largest church in Christendom, built over his tomb. We have the remainder of the day to sample Rome's many delights on our own. Dinner and overnight in Rome. (B/D)

DAY 4: ROME

Today we enjoy a full day tour of Rome. The highlights include the Catacombs, the Appian Way, Capitoline Hill, Basilica of St. Peter in Chains, the Colosseum, the Roman Forum, the Arch of Constantine, and the Circus Maximus. We visit the three major basilicas of Rome: the Basilica of St. Mary Major, one of the oldest shrines dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary and built on the site where the Virgin Mary appeared in a dream of pope Liberius; the Basilica of St. John in Lateran, the former residence of the popes prior to their return to Rome in 1377; the Holy Stairs, which is believed to be a staircase from Pilate's palace in Jerusalem that Jesus climbed when he was condemned to death and brought to Rome by St. Helena in the 4th century. Time permitting, we may climb these stairs on our knees in memory of Christ's Passion. Continue to the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Wall built over his tomb. Dinner and overnight in Rome. (B/D)

DAY 5: ROME/ASSISI

We depart Rome after breakfast for a scenic ride by motorcoach to Assisi. We arrive in the Valley of Assisi where we visit the Basilica of St. Mary of the Angels where St. Francis spent most of his life. Here we visit the Chapel, Porziuncola, the rose bush, and the cave where he retired for prayer. We travel up to the quaint hilltop, birthplace of St. Francis that still retains something of the atmosphere of the early 1200s, the period when St. Francis began his ministry. We visit St. Francis's huge 13th-century Basilica built over his crypt containing many of the saint's possessions and a series of frescoes depicting his life. We continue to the Church of St. Clare to see the saint's incorrupt body. The foundress of the Order of Poor Clares followed the teachings of St. Francis by living a life of poverty and humility. We may kneel before the San Damiano Cross from which Jesus spoke to St. Francis asking him to rebuild His church. Dinner and overnight in Assisi. (B/D)

DAY 6: ASSISI

Enjoy a day of leisure in Assisi. Walk the quaint narrow streets to shop, enjoy the local cafes, or take an optional tour (at additional cost) up to the Hermitage of Carceri located outside Assisi where St. Francis and his followers found a secluded place for prayer and meditation. Saint Francis returned there often throughout his life. Here we truly can see why St. Francis was the Patron Saint of birds, animals, and the environment. Dinner and overnight in Assisi. (B/D)

DAY 7: ASSISI/SIENA/FLORENCE

Today we bid farewell to Assisi as we head for beautiful Siena, located in the central Italian region of Tuscany. Siena's historic center was named a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1995. It is the birthplace of Saint Catherine. We visit the Piazza del Campo, the Cathedral, the Basilica of St. Francis which contains the miraculous consecrated hosts still intact since 1730, and the Basilica of San Domenico where we view the incorrupt head of St. Catherine. We continue to Florence and upon arrival enjoy city tour including visits to the Duomo, the Santa Croce Church and the famous status of "David" by Michelangelo located on Accademia Gallery. Dinner and overnight in Florence. (B/D)

DAY 8: FLORENCE/MILAN

Morning at leisure to explore this Renaissance city on your own. Enjoy shopping for leather, jewelry, and glassware before we depart for Milan, Italy's second most populous city. Our orientation tour will take us past Duomo Square, the Cathedral, and La Scala Opera House before we check into our hotel. Dinner and overnight in the Milan area. (B/D)

DAY 9: MILAN/NEW YORK

After breakfast we transfer to Milan airport for our flight back home arriving the same day. (B)

NOTE: Papal Audience is possible only on Wednesdays and is subject of confirmation. It can be cancelled without prior notice, depends on The Pope's schedule

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Tour prices: All prices in this brochure are based on airfares, land rates and exchange rates in effect at the time of printing and on group rates of 30 passengers or more. Tours may depart with less than the required number of passengers, at the discretion of Group IST, LLC (doing business and referred to therein as "Regina Tours"), but an additional charge may apply. Passengers will be advised about such surcharges 60 days before departure. All prices are subject to change without notice prior to departure due to major currency fluctuations, changes in fuel prices and/or unforeseen economic circumstances.

Reservations, Deposits and Final Payments: Please complete the Participant Agreement, with full names as they appear on passports, and mail it to us with the required per person deposit plus applicable (optional) insurance. Receipt of your deposit shall act as your agreement to these terms and conditions. Balance is due 75 days before departure date. If final payment is received less than 75 days, a late fee will be assessed in the amount of \$50.00. If final payment is made by credit card (American Express, Visa, MasterCard), Regina Tours requires a completed credit card authorization form. All payments made by check should be made payable to Regina Tours.

Late Reservations: If a booking is made within 60 days of departure, full payment plus applicable taxes and optional insurance is due at the time of booking. There will be a \$50.00 late processing fee applicable plus cost of any express or overnight mail services. No personal checks will be accepted with reservations received 30 days or less before departure date. Money order, bank check, certified check or credit cards (American Express, Visa, and MasterCard) will be accepted.

Travel Documents: A valid passport (valid for six months after the return date of the trip) is required to travel. Visa is required for US passport holders traveling to some destinations; please contact our office for details. All non-US citizens must contact the appropriate consular office for entry visa requirements pertaining to their trip. In addition non US citizens are responsible for complying with requirements for re-entry into the USA. Regina Tours assumes no responsibility for procurement of passport or visas. Obtaining and carrying these documents is the sole responsibility of passengers. Regina Tours will not be responsible for any delays, damages and/or losses, including missed portions of your trip due to improper travel documentation.

Final Documents and Tickets: All documents and tickets are only issued upon receipt of final payment and are sent within 3 weeks of departure. Documents and tickets are not guaranteed if final payment and booking form are not received on time.

Air from Home City: All brochure departures are based on a New York area airport. Regina Tours can help arrange air transportation from your home city airport. Regina Tours is not responsible for any penalties incurred on domestic tickets not purchased from us, in case of changes in the schedule of the tour. If you are making your own domestic airline tickets, please make sure that your domestic flight time arrives at least 4 hours prior to your international departure time.

Air Changes, Cancellations & Refunds: Airline tickets issued by Regina Tours are highly restrictive and in most instances cannot be reissued, revalidated or exchanged. If a change is possible, a \$75 per person administrative fee, plus any applicable airline change fees, will be assessed once air tickets have been issued. Airline penalties vary depending on carrier.

Airline Seat Assignments and Special Services: There is no advance seat selection. Early check-in is necessary to secure seats with travel companions. Seating is solely under control of the airlines. Some airlines used may be eligible for frequent flyer mileage.

Baggage: The company is not responsible for any additional charges collected by the carriers at the airport for luggage fees. We recommend that you take along one suitcase per person with a maximum weight of 50lbs., plus one carry on with maximum dimensions of 9"X14"X22". Airlines also have their own baggage restrictions; please check with the air carrier prior to your departure. All baggage is the passenger's responsibility throughout the tour. Regina Tours is not responsible for loss, theft or damage to your baggage. If a bag is lost or damaged In-flight, the passenger is responsible for notifying the airline directly.

Airline Clause: The airlines concerned will not be held responsible for any act, omission, or event during the time passengers are not aboard their aircraft. The passenger tickets in use by the airline, when issued, shall constitute the sole contract between airline and the purchaser of these tickets and/or passenger. These tours may be sold in connection with the services of any ATC or IATA Airline.

Rooms: Prices shown in the brochure are per person, based on two persons sharing a hotel room or cabin. A limited number of single rooms are available at the supplement shown per tour. In some cases, when requested, we may be able to find an appropriate roommate for passengers who have booked as a single person. **If a roommate is not available, you must pay the single room supplement.** While single rooms provide privacy they are often smaller than twin bedrooms. Triple rooms are available in many hotels for family or friends traveling together. There are no discounts for triple rooms.

Medical Conditions: While we endeavor to provide the highest level of service to all our passengers, we cannot guarantee special facilities or assistance for disabled passengers and it is your responsibility to arrange for such assistance as required. We regret that we cannot provide individual assistance Regina Tours is not responsible for any medical conditions that may occur prior, during, or after the tour.

Land Only Bookings & Tour Deviations: All Regina Tours packages include airfare from the city designated. Land only bookings will be invoiced based on adjusted price. Arrival and departure transfers are not provided for land only bookings. Any deviations from the tour, requested by the client, will be assessed a charge of \$100.00 per person, plus any additional costs the change may incur.

If you cancel your tour after you have received your documents and airline tickets, you must return them to Regina Tours before we can process your refund.
