DAILY ITINERARY

DAY 1 – NEWYORK / TIRANA

We depart on our overnight international flight to Tirana, the vibrant capital of Albania. As we begin this meaningful pilgrimage tracing the life and legacy of Saint Mother Teresa, we enjoy in-flight meals and prepare spiritually for the days ahead.

DAY 2 – TIRANA

Upon arrival in Tirana, we are welcomed by our Tour Escort and transferred to our hotel. Depending on arrival time, we may enjoy an introductory orientation of the city, offering a first glimpse into Albania's rich cultural tapestry shaped by faith, resilience, and history. Dinner and overnight in Tirana. (D)

DAY 3 – TIRANA / ELBASAN / OHRID

Today is dedicated to the early life of Saint Mother Teresa. We visit the Mother Teresa Pavilion, where personal artifacts, photographs, and letters offer insight into her extraordinary vocation and humble beginnings. We continue to the family residence on Kavaja Street, where her mother and sister lived, providing a poignant connection to her formative years. At Mother Teresa Square, we reflect on her enduring influence in her homeland, before visiting St. Paul's Cathedral. This modern cathedral, dedicated to her legacy, features striking stained-glass windows and a mosaic portraying her life's mission of charity and compassion. We then depart Albania, pausing in Elbasan, and crossing into North Macedonia, we arrive in Ohrid, beautifully set along the shores of Lake Ohrid. Dinner and overnight in Ohrid. (B/D)

DAY 4 – OHRID / SKOPJE

Ohrid, often called the "Jerusalem of the Balkans," is one of Europe's oldest settlements and a UNESCO World Heritage Site, once said to have had 365 churches—one for each day of the year. We begin at the Church of St. Sophia, a masterpiece of medieval architecture adorned with remarkably preserved frescoes depicting patriarchs, saints, and liturgical scenes. We then visit the iconic Church of St. John at Kaneo, dramatically perched above the lake, offering breathtaking panoramic views and a peaceful setting for reflection. Next, we explore the Church of the Holy Mother of God Peribleptos, renowned for its vivid frescoes that illustrate the Passion of Christ, the life of the Virgin Mary, and key biblical narratives with extraordinary artistic detail. In the afternoon, we continue to Skopje. Dinner and overnight in Skopje. (B/D)

DAY 5 – SKOPJE / PRIZREN

In Skopje, birthplace of Saint Mother Teresa, we visit the Memorial House of Mother Teresa, built on the site of her childhood parish. The museum tells the story of her life through multimedia exhibits, personal belongings, and a chapel for quiet prayer. We continue to the Cathedral of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, a symbol of the Catholic presence in the region. Crossing the historic Stone Bridge, we enter the Old Bazaar,

one of the oldest and largest marketplaces in the Balkans, rich with Ottoman heritage, narrow cobblestone streets, and artisan shops. In the afternoon, we journey to Gorno Nerezi to visit the Church of Saint Panteleimon. This 12th-century Byzantine gem is famed for its expressive frescoes, considered among the earliest examples of emotional realism in Christian art. We celebrate Mass here in this serene and historic setting. Then, we continue to Prizren. Dinner and overnight in Prizren. (B/D)

DAY 6 – PRIZREN / SHKODER

We start the Tour of Prizren, a picturesque town nestled along the Bistrica River, known for its harmonious blend of cultures and religions. We visit the Cathedral of Our Lady of Perpetual Succour, an important center of Catholic worship, where we celebrate Mass. Continuing onward, we arrive in Lac and visit the Church of St. Anthony of Lac, a Catholic shrine dedicated to St. Anthony of Padua. Then, we continue to Shkoder, a historic stronghold of Catholicism in Albania, often called the "Jerusalem of Albania" for its longstanding tradition of religious coexistence and devotion. Dinner and overnight in Shkoder. (B/D)

DAY 7 – SHKODER / PODGORICA

Shkoder holds deep spiritual significance as the ancestral home of the family of Saint Mother Teresa. We visit the St. Stephen's Cathedral, one of the largest Catholic churches in the Balkans, known for its striking interior and role in Albania's religious revival. At the Basilica of Our Lady of Good Counsel, we learn about the miraculous story of the icon that, according to tradition, was transported from Shkoder to Italy during Ottoman times.

We also visit St. Nicholas Church and the Franciscan Church of St. Francis, both reflecting the deep Franciscan roots of the region. In the afternoon, we travel to Podgorica. Dinner and overnight in Podgorica. (B/D)

DAY 8 – PODGORICA / MEDJUGORJE

This morning we journey to Medjugorje, one of the most visited Marian pilgrimage destinations in the world. Since 1981, millions have come here seeking spiritual renewal following reports of apparitions of the Blessed Virgin Mary as Queen of Peace. Upon arrival, we visit the Sanctuary of Our Lady Queen of Peace, centered around St. James Church, where pilgrims gather for prayer, Eucharistic adoration, and confession. We participate in the spiritual program and celebrate Mass (subject to confirmation). Dinner and overnight in Medjugorje. (B/D)

DAY 9 – MEDJUGORJE / APPARITION HILL

This morning we visit Majcino Selo (Mother's Village), a remarkable humanitarian project founded during the Balkan War to care for orphaned and disadvantaged children. It stands today as a living testimony to Christian charity and compassion.

DAILY ITINERARY

We celebrate Mass here in this deeply moving environment. In the afternoon, we climb Apparition Hill, the site of the first reported apparitions. Along the rocky path, we pray the Rosary and reflect on the mysteries of faith, culminating at the statue of Our Lady—a profoundly spiritual and unforgettable experience. Dinner and overnight in Medjugorje. (B/D)

DAY 10 – MEDJUGORJE / NEWYORK

After breakfast, we transfer to the airport in Split, Dubrovnik, or Sarajevo for our return flight home. We arrive the same day, carrying with us the spiritual fruits and lasting memories of this extraordinary pilgrimage. (B)

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Tour prices: All prices in this brochure are based on airfares, land rates and exchange rates in effect at the time of printing and on group rates of 30 passengers or more. Tours may depart with less than the required number of passengers, at the discretion of Group IST, LLC (doing business and referred to therein as "Regina Tours"), but an additional charge may apply. Passengers will be advised about such surcharges 60 days before departure. All prices are subject to change without notice prior to departure due to major currency fluctuations, changes in fuel prices and/or unforeseen economic circumstances.

Reservations, Deposits and Final Payments: Please complete the Participant Agreement, with full names as they appear on passports, and mail it to us with the required per person deposit plus applicable (optional) insurance. Receipt of your deposit shall act as your agreement to these terms and conditions. Balance is due 75 days before departure date. If final payment is received less than 75 days, a late fee will be accessed in the amount of \$50.00. If final payment is made by credit card (American Express, Visa, MasterCard), Regina Tours requires a completed credit card authorization form. All payments made by check should be made payable to Regina Tours.

Late Reservations: If a booking is made within 60 days of departure, full payment plus applicable taxes and optional insurance is due at the time of booking. There will be a \$50.00 late processing fee applicable plus cost of any express or overnight mail services. No personal checks will be accepted with reservations received 30 days or less before departure date. Money order, bank check, certified check or credit cards (American Express, Visa, and MasterCard) will be accepted.

Travel Documents: A valid passport (valid for six months after the return date of the trip) is required to travel. Visa is required for US passport holders traveling to some destinations; please contact our office for details. All non-US citizens must contact the appropriate consular office for entry visa requirements pertaining to their trip. In addition non US citizens are responsible for complying with requirements for re-entry into the USA. Regina Tours assumes no responsibility for procurement of passport or visas. Obtaining and carrying these documents is the sole responsibility of passengers. Regina Tours will not be responsible for any delays, damages and/or losses, including missed portions of your trip due to improper travel documentation.

Final Documents and Tickets: All documents and tickets are only issued upon receipt of final payment and are sent within 3 weeks of departure. Documents and tickets are not guaranteed if final payment and booking form are not received on time.

Air from Home City: All brochure departures are based on a New York area airport. Regina Tours can help arrange air transportation from your home city airport. Regina Tours is not responsible for any penalties incurred on domestic tickets not purchased from us, in case of changes in the schedule of the tour. If you are making your own domestic airline tickets, please make sure that your domestic flight time arrives at least 4 hours prior to your international departure time.

Air Changes, Cancellations & Refunds: Airline tickets issued by Regina Tours are highly restrictive and in most instances cannot be reissued, revalidated or exchanged. If a change is possible, a \$75 per person administrative fee, plus any applicable airline change fees, will be assessed once air tickets have been issued. Airline penalties vary depending on carrier.

Airline Seat Assignments and Special Services: There is no advance seat selection. Early check-in is necessary to secure seats with travel companions. Seating is solely under control of the airlines. Some airfares used may be eligible for frequent flyer mileage.

Baggage: The company is not responsible for any additional charges collected by the carriers at the airport for luggage fees. We recommend that you take along one suitcase per person with a maximum weight of 50lbs., plus one carry on with maximum dimensions of 9"x14"x22". Airlines also have their own baggage restrictions; please check with the air carrier prior to your departure. All baggage is the passenger's responsibility throughout the tour. Regina Tours is not responsible for loss, theft or damage to your baggage. If a bag is lost or damaged in-flight, the passenger is responsible for notifying the airline directly.

Airline Clause: The airlines concerned will not be held responsible for any act, omission, or event during the time passengers are not aboard their aircraft. The passenger tickets in use by the airline, when issued, shall constitute the sole contract between airline and the purchaser of these tickets and/or passenger. These tours may be sold in connection with the services of any ATC or IATA Airline.

Rooms: Prices shown in the brochure are per person, based on two persons sharing a hotel room or cabin. A limited number of single rooms are available at the supplement shown per tour. In some cases, when requested, we may be able to find an appropriate roommate for passengers who have booked as a single person. **If a roommate is not available, you must pay the single room supplement.** While single rooms provide privacy they are often smaller than twin bedrooms. Triple rooms are available in many hotels for family or friends traveling together. There are no discounts for triple rooms.

Medical Conditions: While we endeavor to provide the highest level of service to all our passengers, we cannot guarantee special facilities or assistance for disabled passengers and it is your responsibility to arrange for such assistance as required. We regret that we cannot provide individual assistance. Regina Tours is not responsible for any medical conditions that may occur prior, during, or after the tour.

Land Only Bookings & Tour Deviations: All Regina Tours packages include airfare from the city designated. Land only bookings will be invoiced based on adjusted price. Arrival and departure transfers are not provided for land only bookings. Any deviations from the tour, requested by the client, will be assessed a charge of \$100.00 per person, plus any additional costs the change may incur.

However, should you need to cancel, your cancellation must be received in writing, via email, fax or by letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. If you cancel your tour after you have received your documents and airline tickets, you must return them to Regina Tours before we can process your refund.
